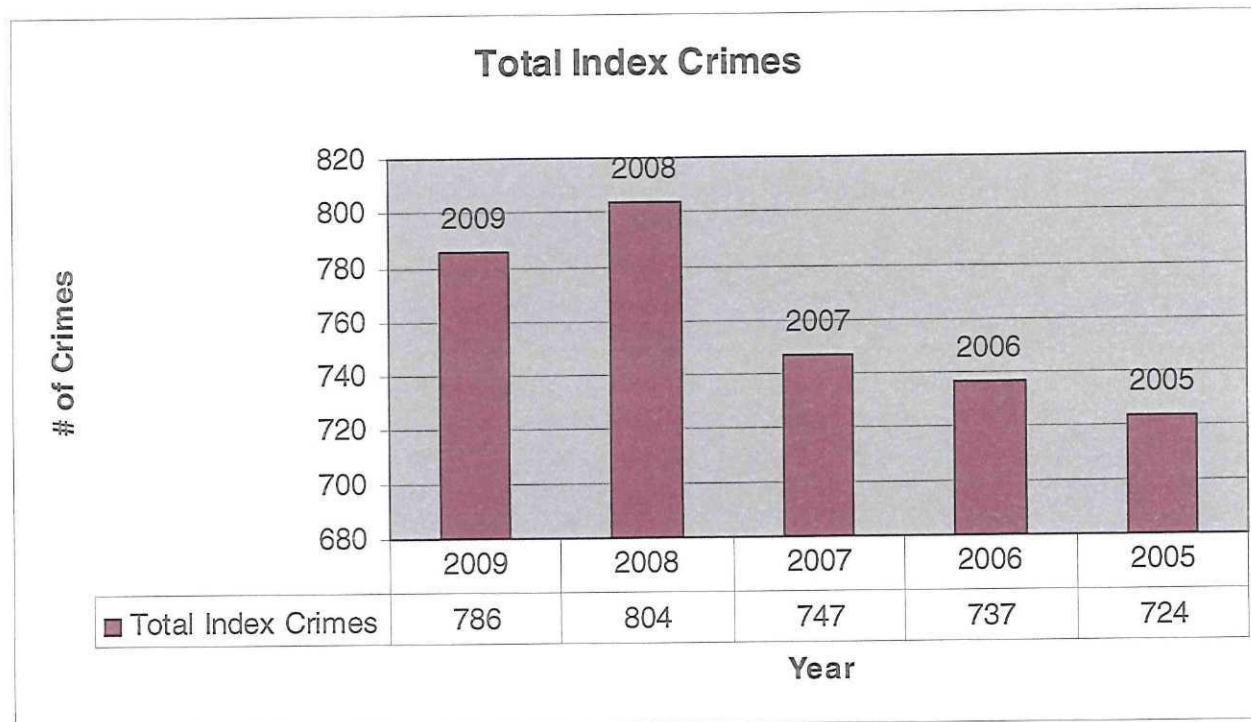
The above table shows the Crime Trend in Wilton Manors based on Uniform Crime Reporting statistical information.

**The Total Index Crime includes:** Criminal Homicide, Forcible Sex Offenses, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Residential and Business Burglary, Theft (including burglary of motor vehicles), Theft Motor Vehicle, and Arson.

**Violent Crime includes:** Criminal Homicide, Forcible Sex Offenses, Robbery, and Aggravated Assault.

**Non-violent Crime includes:** Burglary, Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson.

**Crime Rate:** Shows the number of crimes per 1,000 populations (the total index crimes divided by the population, times 1,000 population). (Population figures were obtained from data supplied by Florida Department of Law Enforcement).



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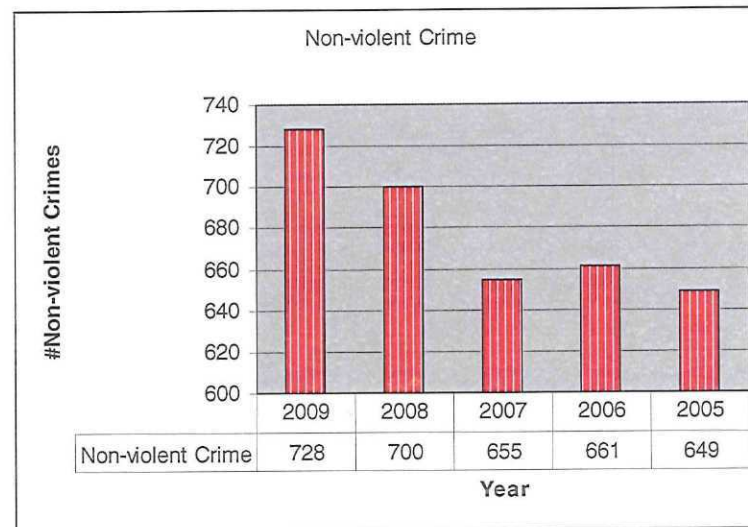
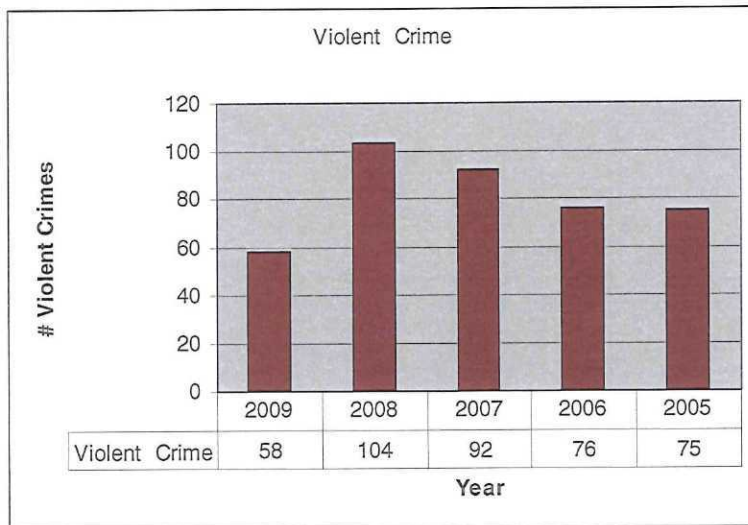
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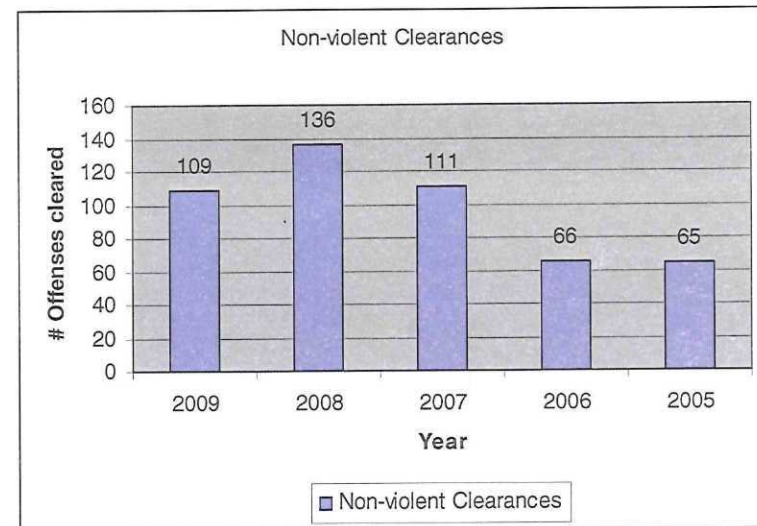
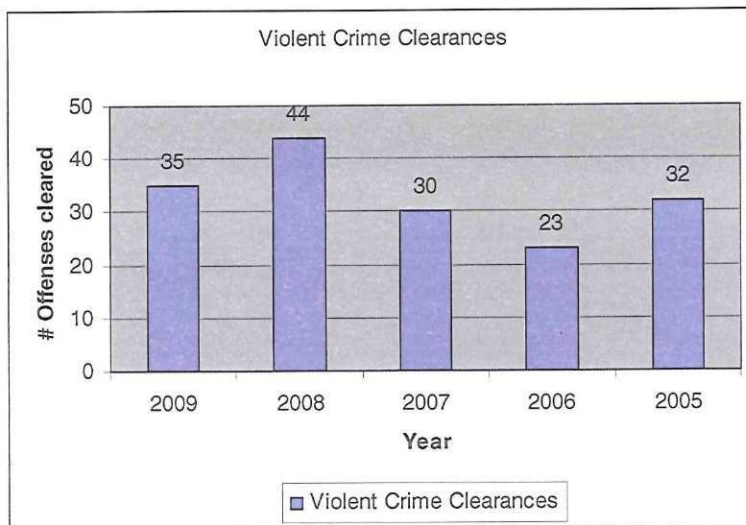

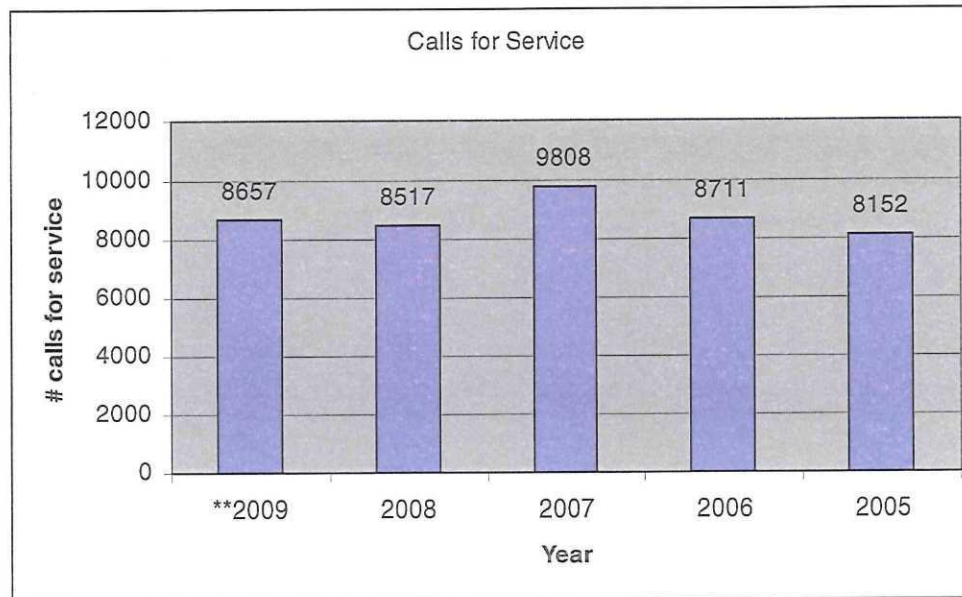

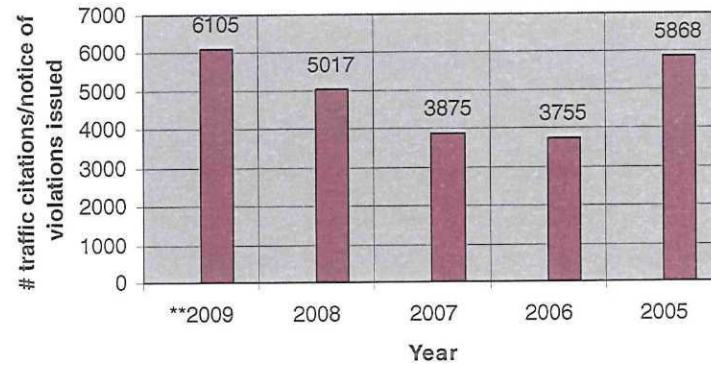

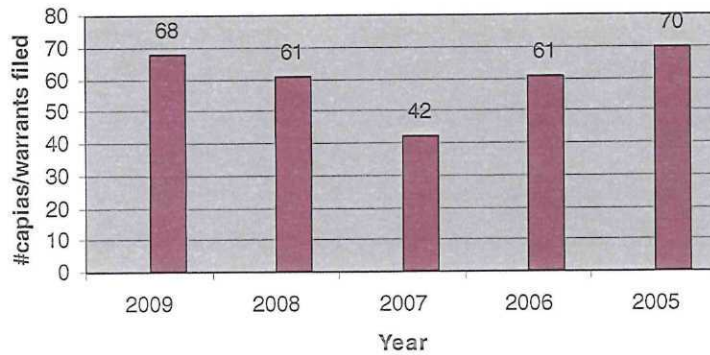
**Capias Arrests**
